## OUR COVER IMAGE

**Daniel Janzen and Winnie Hallwachs** are world-renowned biologists from the University of Pennsylvania. Among their numerous accomplishments, this married couple has spent much of their careers living in Área de Conservación Guanacaste, Sector Santa Rosa, in Costa Rica, focusing on forest reforestation and conservation through non-damaging biodiversity development. The cover image of this issue was taken in their house in AGG, and depicts an adult hylid frog (*Trachycephalus typhonius*; formerly known as *Phrynohyas venulosa*) feeding on a scorpion (*Centruroides* sp.); the species could not be identified because three species of *Centruroides* live in the house. The photograph was taken about 2–3 minutes after the frog captured the scorpion, and the ingestion process lasted about 8

minutes. The frog apparently was stung many times by the scorpion, but did not show any side effects.
