OUR COVER IMAGE

Elí García-Padilla is a Mexican independent scientist and photographer. To date he has authored more than 70 scientific papers and notes, dealing mostly with the distribution, natural history, and conservation of the Mexican herpetofauna. His photographs, some of which have received awards, have appeared in various magazines, journals, and books on photography. Our cover image depicts a young *Caiman crocodilus* in its mangrove habitat at Isla La Concepción, Acapetahua, Chiapas, Mexico. Elí is indebted to Haydée Morales-Flores for companionship in the field, and Humberto Yee and his family for logistical support, but more importantly for their efforts in preserving this beautiful piece of paradise. A molecular study has shown that the population of *C. crocodilus* in Chiapas, described as the subspecies *chiapasius*, constitutes a distinct evolutionary lineage.
